INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

For a scholarship application to be considered the following requirements must be met:

- Files a typewritten application furnished by the ACUSBCA Scholarship Committee, giving complete information as required. Application must be postmarked no later than January 15th of current year.
- Application is to be filed with the ACUSBCA, who in turn will refer the applications to the Scholarship Committee.
- Has unimpaired amateur standing in all athletics.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

- Complete General Information, Bowling History and Statement of Need sections.
- Attach to the scholarship application a handwritten essay of at least 200 words outlining your special interests and goals. Include in what way this scholarship will be used. Judging will be based upon inclusion of specific plans, clarity, organization and neatness.
- Mail both the completed application and handwritten essay to the Ada County USBC Association; application must be postmarked on or before January 15th of the year in which the application is to be considered.
- Give the SCHOOL OFFICIAL OR COUNSELOR'S EVALUATION & DATA section of the application to a school official or your school counselor along with a stamped envelope addressed to the Ada County USBC Association. It must be postmarked on or before January 15th of the year in which the application is to be considered.
- Give the COACHES EVALUATION AND DATA SHEET section of the application to each coach along with a stamped envelope addressed to the Ada County USBC Association. It must be postmarked on or before January 15th of the year in which the application is to be considered. The coach's evaluation shall not be made by an applicant's parent.
